

Igor Žibrik, Member of Nova KBM's Management Board

Igor Žibrik became a member of Nova KBM's Management Board on 18 August 2012

On 6 June 2012, the Supervisory Board of Nova KBM appointed Igor Žibrik as a Member of the Bank's Management Board. He started his five-year term of office on 18 August 2012, after being granted a licence by the Bank of Slovenia.

Igor Žibrik has 18 years of experience in leading positions within financial institutions, both at home and internationally. He started his banking career in 1994 as the head of sales and product development in the Investment Banking Department of Creditanstalt. In addition to performing this office, he participated in the setting up of the infrastructure for foreign investments in the Slovene capital market. In 1998, he took up a position as the head of sales for Central and Eastern Europe in the Securities Division of Bank Austria Creditanstalt (BACA) in Vienna, with his main responsibility being customer relations. He was the director in the International Markets Division at BACA HVB Bank in Prague between 2002 and 2005. In the following three years he served as the director of the Corporate Department at Raiffeisen Krekova banka, during which time he successfully restructured and reorganised this business division. A year later, he was appointed as the director of the Corporate Banking Department at NLB. Before joining Nova KBM, he was a Member of the Management Board at NLB Prishtina between 2008 and 2012, responsible for risk management, financial institutions and controlling.

Born in 1967, he has a BSc from the Faculty of Economics and Business in Maribor, and an MSc from the University of California in Santa Cruz.

He is fluent in English, German, Croatian, French, Italian, Czech, Serbian and Albanian.
