Cross-border payment transactions are payment transactions effected between Member States in any Member State currency.

Other payment transactions are payment transactions effected within Slovenia or between Member States in third countries' currencies, and payment transactions effected to/from third countries in any currency.

^{******} Cut-off time for executing cross-border and other payment transactions to be credited to accounts of other banks (abroad or in Slovenia) is the cut-off time for executing a payment in Nova KBM and **not** the cut-off time for crediting a payment to the payee's account at a third bank. Nova KBM executes SEPA payments (received by 15:00 hours), urgent payments and other payment transactions to be credited to the accounts of domestic banks in the same day with the same-day value date, and other cross-border and other payment transactions and SEPA payments received after 15:00 hours in the same day but with a value date 1 business day.

^{****} Working day (Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday) up to which the payee needs to provide data for SEPA DB. The payee can provide the required data no more than 14 calendar days prior to the expected date of debit.

^{*****} If the payment is received after the cut-off time or on a non-working day, then it is considered to be received on the first following working day after that.
